

Pre-boarding Home Evaluation

The purpose of this evaluation is to give us a good idea of your dog's behaviors prior to coming in, so we can interact with your pet in the most stress-free way possible for them.

For the first portion of the evaluation, we will have you rank their behaviors on a scale of 1-5; 1 being calm, with little to no reaction, and 5 being extremely over-reactive and hard to calm down.

Excitability
